The Biggest Ravioli In the World, And Other Finds

There's a new 10,000-square-foot player in the TriBeCa design world: Dune, at 88 Franklin Street (near Church Street; 212-925-6171), sells an exclusive line of furniture and textiles by contemporary designers. The duplex space was designed by Nick Dine and its president, Richard Shemtov, whose work is also sold there. The floor, which looks like concrete, is actually poured resin, a much softer surface. The Floor Ravioli cushion by Mr. Dine, inset bottom, is 80 inches by 80 inches (\$2,370). Dune's collection includes the walnut dining table (\$3,982) by David Khouri, with chairs (\$1,750 each, in ultrasuede). The 6-by-9-foot wool rugs, from left, are by Harry Allen (\$4,570), Jens Denecke (\$3,890) and Mr. Shemtov (\$4,125).

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
